Dabledoo Music:

Performing

- Click on resources & click on the clock

Last week we looked at different sounds we hear and associate with summer time. Now we will use these sounds to create a musical performance. There are four colour groups and give each group a summery sound to make. Start with the voice and introduce instruments if you have any at home, e.g. shakers for the colour making the sound of wind through the trees. Repeat and refine this performance until you have used a combination of voice and instruments.

Composing & Performing

- Now select Part 2 Compose

Once you are happy with your summer sounds, create your own arrangement of the performance. You can change the colours of the Clock.

Here are the instructions to access Dabledoo in case you need them:

There is a 'Parents Subscription' to DabledooMusic to have full access to music resources. It is very simple to enrol. Go to dabledoomusic.com and click on 'Parents Subscription – Full Access *FREE for Parents and Teachers*'. You will have to fill in a few details and then you are set up. There are video tutorials on how to get started so you know how to navigate the online resource. It is a very fun and interactive way to learn more about music and we will give you guidance on what to do each week.
