Application and Decision Dates for admission to Junior Infants 2022

Criteria for Enrolment to Junior Infants

Applicants must be at least four years of age before the **First of June** of the year in which they apply. Compulsory attendance at school does not apply until the age of six years. Junior Infants must start school during the month of September, as places will not be reserved after the 30^{th} September.

The catchment area, for enrolment purposes consists of the following housing estates in the parish of Huntstown: Castaheany & Hansfield estates (off Littlepace Rd.), Deerhaven, Hazelbury, Hunters Run, Littlepace, Pheasant Run.

Special Class Application and Decision Dates for admission to Special Class 2022

The following are the dates applicable for admission to the school's Special Class which caters for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder

Criteria for Enrolment to our Special Class

Applicants must be at least four years of age before the First of June of the year in which they apply and no more than eight years of age at the start of the school year for which they are applying. No child will be retained in the special class or school beyond the 30th of June after their 9th birthday. Compulsory attendance at school does not apply until the age of six years.

- Each child must have a primary diagnosis of Autism/Autistic Spectrum Disorder using the DSM V or ICD 10 as set out by a professional approved by the Department of Education & Skills and a Multi Disciplinary assessment report.
- A recommendation that a special class placement is best for the child must be clearly stated in the child's reports
