1. Maths tables: 8+
2. Maths: Brain Teasers -next two tests. Set a timer for 4 minutes per test!

4. Spellings: JP List 26. Please also write each word in a sentence into your copy.
5. Handwriting: Spring is my favourite season. Please write this sentence 4 times in handwriting copies.
6. Reading: Children should continue to read daily, either reading books from home or online. Please also continue to read stories to your children and discuss the stories with them (you could ask children to summarise the story, tell you about their favourite part, characters etc.).
7. Gaeilge: "Ag imirt rugbai " Lesson 22 [www.folensonline.ie](http://www.folensonline.ie)  
Select the book Abair Liom C for 1st class.  
There are 2 options available - Ebook or resources - Select resources.  
Click on Lesson (on the left at the top of the page) and click on lesson 22-Ag Imirt Rugbai  
Explore the following 3 options in this lesson with your child : Comhrá, Pléasc an Bálún and Póstaer.
8. Make a poster for your bedroom window to thank the health care workers for all they are doing to mind people in our country.
9. Exercise! Children should continue to exercise indoors or outdoors using some of the super troopers ideas or websites like [cosmickids.com](http://cosmickids.com) and [gonoodle.com](http://gonoodle.com).

11. Report writing: Children write a report on their favourite film.
